"...Regresan de la tumba" (BCore, 06) is a dark, energetic and dynamic recording which, with bursts like "Mundaka" or "Vulcan", show their strength and power, along with classic ballads like the glossy "Ojos Verdes", that also have a place in the demerital world of these dead faceless characters. Influenced by legends like The Ventures or The Shadows, and also by the intensity of Dead Kennedys or JFA, with an incendiary live show as a dance of masks, these infernal playboys are here to bring us pure diversion and evil frenzy.
